

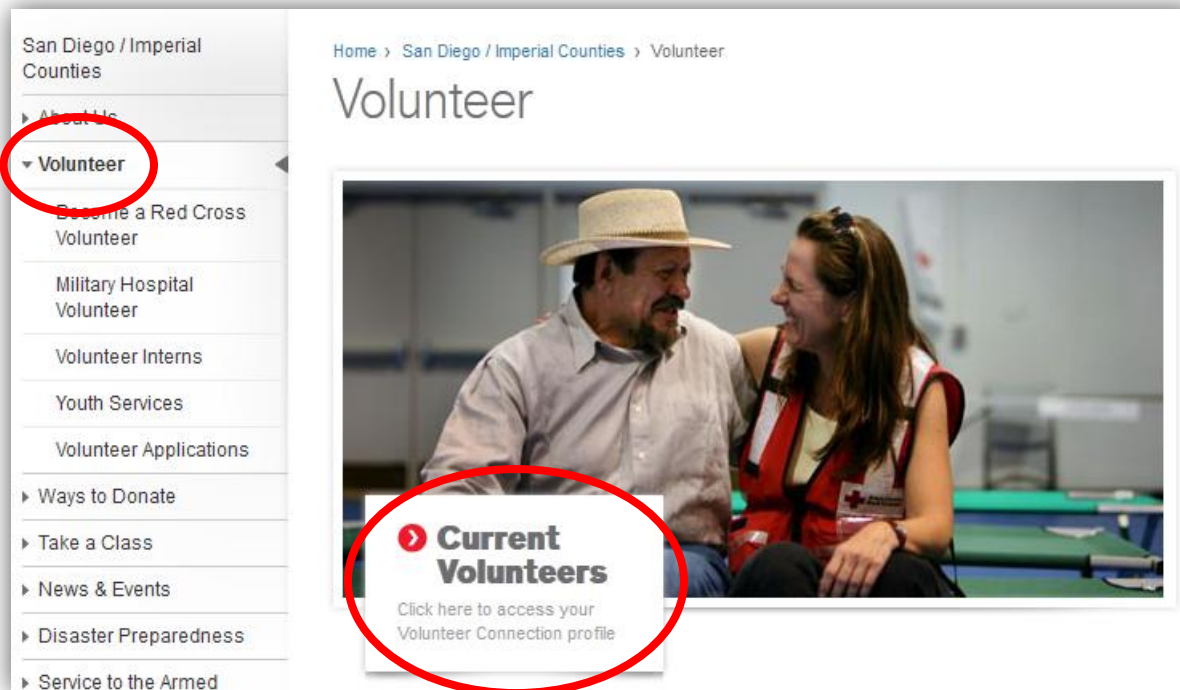

### About Feeding

One of the direct services to clients on a relief operation, the Feeding activity provides direct assistance to individuals affected by man-made or natural disasters, ranging from single family home incidents to larger events such as earthquakes and wildfires and catastrophic incidents. Our clients include people affected by the disaster and first responders, including fire, police, swat, search & rescue. Our chapter averages 2-3 canteen operations per month and we are lucky to have five canteen vehicles designated and stocked to provide support at a moment's notice.

- Support the Nutrition Education Special Projects, including: an 8 Week Weight Loss Program, Employee Wellness Program, Cooking Demonstrations, Hands-On Cooking Classes and Food Safety.
- Travel to one or more of six WIC sites to assist in the set-up and clean-up of four monthly classes including a Weight Loss Program Orientation, Workout class, Cooking Demonstration, and Cooking Live! Class
